ATTENTION INFANT PARENTS

Please be aware per state licensing children are prohibited for safety purposes from sleeping in the upright position while in attendance at Play & Grow Learning Center, LLC. This includes car seats, swings, bouncy seats, etc. This is due to the narrowing of the airway caused when children are propped upward while sleeping. If you would prefer to have your child sleep in the previously mentioned seats a physician's note is required stating specifically that your child is able to sleep in the "upright position." If you have any questions and/or concerns, please see a member of management.

Parents - Please remember that if you are planning on taking off during the holidays to mark your child off on the attendance sheet outside of his/her classroom door. If you are looking to use your week of vacation for the holidays, it **MUST** be turned in two weeks prior to the requested time off.
